

School of Radiography

Make sure all documents are in! For questions, please feel free to contact the admissions representative, Garrett Gray, at 501-202-7740, or ahadmissions@baptist-health.org. Once the applicant file is complete (all documents have been received), the applicant will be notified of an interview date and time. An interview with the selection committee is the last step in the applicant process. It is the applicant's responsibility to turn in all needed items for the program application process. Failure to finish the application requirements will result in an incomplete application file and non-acceptance to the program.

Checklist for the School of Radiography:

*In addition to the basic requirements to apply to the Radiography program, the following documents/qualifications must be met to be reviewed for acceptance.

- **Application on file for the calendar year**
- **Official high school transcripts/GED certification**
 - Contact the high school attended to obtain official transcripts. If the applicant's high school is no longer in service, contact the Arkansas Department of Education. To obtain official GED scores, contact the Arkansas Department of Education.
- **Official ACT/SAT scores**
 - ACT score of 19 or above is preferred, with a preference of 17 or above in math and science. BHCLR does NOT super score.
 - BHCLR offers the ACT on our campus as a residual testing site. To register for the ACT, visit bhclr.edu, Prospective Students, then ACT registration.
- **Official college/university transcripts**
 - BHCLR requires an official transcript for each college/university attended. The attended colleges/universities listed on your application will be assumed to be the only colleges/universities attended until the applicant file is sent for an academic audit. The academic audit will determine if all college/university transcripts have been received. Failure to list all colleges/universities attended may result in non-selection due to insufficient information given.
- **Personal statement**
 - To obtain the personal statement form, visit bhclr.edu, Programs of Study, then Radiography under requirements.
- **Observation hours (paused for 2021 application cycle due to COVID-19 Pandemic)**
 - To obtain the observation form, visit bhclr.edu, Programs of Study, then Radiography under requirements.
 - The School of Radiography requires an observation experience for all program applicants. This experience must be six (6) hours and may be completed in any

Diagnostic Radiology Department under the supervision of a registered radiographer (R.T. (R)). This requirement must be met and all forms returned by the file completion deadline of March 15th.

- **Financial Aid (optional)**
 - BHCLR Foundation Scholarships are available each semester to select BHCLR students. A new application is available online, in person with the Financial Aid office, or by request with the Financial Aid office by email or over the phone. For questions about the BHCLR Foundation Scholarships, please contact 501-202-7486, or financialaid@bhclr.edu.
 - Important note: As an affiliate university student, all financial aid will be completed through the affiliate university. Students at BHCLR are still eligible for BHCLR Foundation Scholarships.
