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PURPOSE: To maintain an optimally safe and secure teaching and learning environment.

POLICY: Baptist Health (BH) security officers are assigned to all BH facilities to safeguard employees,

students, guests and property. Maintaining a safe working environment is the responsibility of

each employee.

PROCESS: 1. Faculty and staff are to assist in this effort by:

Ensuring that all students and employees wear I.D. badges.

Being alert for any suspicious person or event.

Locking supply rooms and offices.

Returning equipment to proper storage areas.

Being alert when entering or leaving premises after school and office hours.

Looking in your own car before entering.

Being informed regarding safety codes.

Knowing the location of fire extinguishers and alarms.

Knowing school evacuation procedures.

Cleaning up spills and articles on floors.

Reporting defective equipment or hazardous conditions.

Not allowing visitors to follow behind you through the doors.
